

Autumn 1 **Topic**

Enchanted Woodland

This half term, the topic has a **geography** focus, with children learning about different trees and plants, including wider physical features such as hills, mountains, forests . We also look at David Attenborough and his work with animals and their habitats, as well as wider features of habitats, such as natural weather patterns.

In English, we will be looking at a range of traditional and fairy tales; with their plots contrasting good and evil, most will be familiar to the children from their time in EYFS. We will continue to develop the art of storytelling, both orally and in our writing, with themes of kindness, courage, love and Tens envy! 1


In maths, the children will learn number and place value to 10 (counting forwards, backwards and ordering numbers), and addition and subtraction to 10. They will also be learning about the names and features of 2D and 3D shapes.

Our computing topic is all about being safe online and the children will be learning the basics of logging on and using PurpleMash.

Autumn 2 Topic

Paws, Claws & Whiskers

This half term, the topic has a **science** focus, with children learning about different animals, including humans. The children will learn about herbivores, carnivores, and omnivores. They will also name different animals. Children will learn that humans are animals too and will label the basic body parts. In **English**, we will be looking at a range of books by the fabulous author Emily Gravett—who loves to write and draw about







animals. The children will be writing non-fiction texts (all about animals) and biographies (all about humans)!
