Virtual Tour: Reception (FS2)



Reception (FS2) children enter via the vehicle access and then line up on the right hand side of the drive.



Yellow feet are painted on the driveway to help children keep their distance from each other.

Miss Edwards, Mrs Knight and Mrs Graham meet the children here and lead them into the classroom.



They will walk through the gate and follow the yellow, painted feet to the classroom door.








The EYFS building is split into Reception and Nursery by this red room divider.

Whilst we previously held joint assemblies and events, these 'bubbles' will be kept separate under the current guidance.



This is the creative area, where children can make, paint, draw and create!

It also includes a 'Funky Fingers' table, which is set up with activities to develop children's small motor control, e.g. threading or making puppets.



There are two computers in the classroom for the children to use.

We also have a small number of mini iPads.



There is an interactive whiteboard and plenty of room for the children to sit on the carpet for whole class teaching – such as during the register or story time.



We work hard to have lots of lovely displays, some of which show the children's work and some of which help them with their learning.



We have a number of different learning areas in the classroom.

Here, one table is set up for writing, with a variety of pencils and a phonics mat.

The other is ready for the children to draw and colour, choosing their own media from the drawers nearby.



There is always a book corner, which has under-gone an update now that we can have soft furnishings back in school.

We are also excited about the return of the role play area – as the advice was not to use one during 'lockdown'.









The children are collected at lunch time by their lunch supervisor (Miss Babs). She will take them down to main school, where they will eat in the hall.



The children will then play on the main school playground.

At the end of lunch time, the children will be taken back to their classroom by Miss Babs.



The children will spend the rest of their day in the Reception classroom and outdoor area.
