#### Staff Update—Lunchtime Supervisors

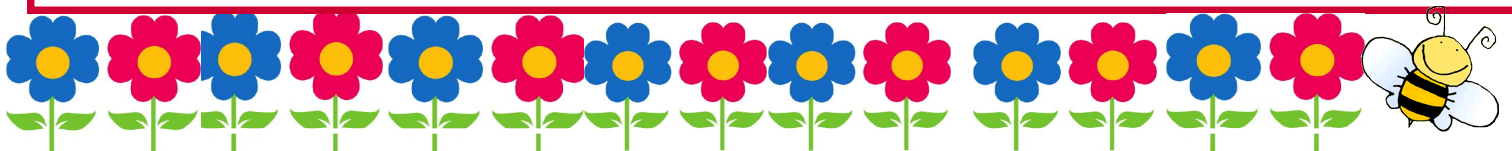

## BE SAFE AND HEALTHY

### Safety at Home Time

Just a reminder that, for the safety of all our pupils, we would like you to follow the arrangements outlined below when picking up your children from school at the end of the day.

FS1 - Parents to line up in the FS1 playground and pick up directly from the FS1 door.

FS2 - Parents to line up by the FS2 building and pick up from the FS2 door exiting down the steps (unless you have a buggy).

Year 1 - to line up by the outdoor classroom and pick children up from the Year 1 fire door.

Years 2, 3 and 4 - Parents to line up on the courts (facing the allotments) with parents of the same Year group. Staff will bring the classes out and release them one at a time to the parents who are lined up in the order. Pupils have been told not to leave the teacher/adult releasing them until they are called. We would politely ask parents not to call their children to them. The staff will only release pupils to an adult they are familiar with. If you have to make arrangements for a different adult to pick up your child, please ring the office and let them know giving a password to the adult, which the teacher will be made aware of.

Year 5 and 6 - are released in the waiting area to the left of the main school entrance. Again, please can parents wait until pupils are released into your care by the class teacher unless you have given school permission for your child to walk home on their own.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

### Jewellery

We have noticed a number of children who are wearing bracelets and necklaces. Children should not be wearing these to school unless they are required to be worn for religious purposes. If this is the case, please could you contact the school office to make us aware of this otherwise staff will ask for them to be removed. If worn for religious purposes, we would ask that they be removed for P.E or covered with a sweat band for the safety of other pupils. We have not, as yet, received many requests and will therefore ask pupils to remove these items if worn to school. Please could I remind parents that pupils with pierced ears should only wear small studs. Thank you.

## Attendance

Here at Kineton Green we are committed to promoting and modelling good attendance and behaviour, which is essential for pupils to achieve their potential.
