Governors very much want to listen to the views of parents, in order to help shape plans and developments for the school as well as keeping you informed as much as possible. Attendance:

Good school attendance has a direct impact on pupil social and emotional well-being, progress and attainment.

We understand that all parents want their child to do the best they possibly can and achieve as much as they can. Kineton Green School also wants this for every pupil. We therefore ask all our parents to ensure that their child/ren are at school by **8.45am** at the latest and that pupils attend every day unless too poorly to do so. I will be operating a number of late gates over the coming weeks to ascertain reasons for pupils who are late or who are late and not accompanied by an adult. Parents of pupils who are persistently or regularly late or have an attendance of below 90% will be asked to attend an attendance panel. For our children's safety we would ask that all absences are now reported by 9.30am. Routine appointments for the doctors or dentist should be booked after 3.30pm.
