The closing date for submitting your child's application for Nursery is 1st December 2018. The closing date for Reception applications is 15th January 2019. If you live in Solihull and you have not yet applied, you must submit your application via the parent portal at www.solihull.gov.uk/pp. Applications received after the closing date will not be processed until after the offers have been made. Applying late is likely to affect the outcome to your application.

If you live outside of Solihull you should contact your home council to apply.
