Year 6 and Year 2 SATs

Year 6 and Year 2 SATs test are just around the corner, starting next week. All our pupils have been working tirelessly, alongside their teachers, to prepare for these governmental tests. Year 6 tests are carried out over the course of the week and then sent off to be marked externally. On Monday through to Thursday we are offering a 'free' breakfast club to all years 6 pupils starting at 8am. The club is a great opportunity for the children to meet together, have breakfast and relax with their friends. If there is any Year 6 children who have siblings who would need to come along in the morning please could you contact Mr Jones as soon as possible and we will do our best to support. Year 2 is also taking part in SATs testing over the next two weeks. These tests are to aid teacher assessment only and are not marked externally.

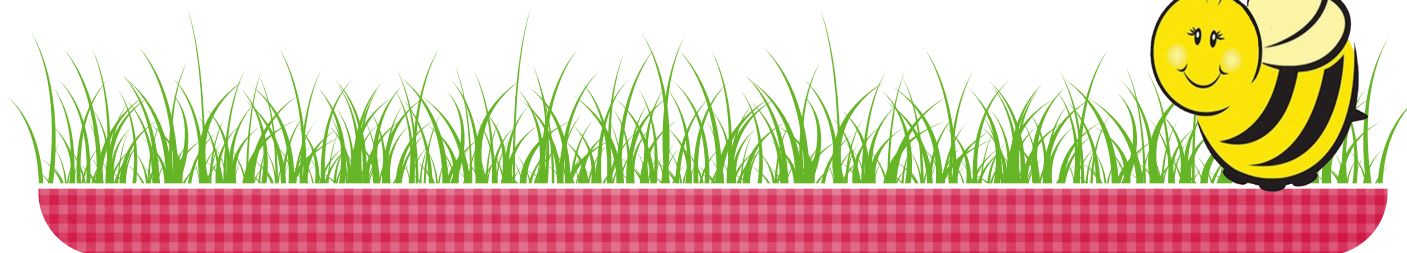
