### Flip and Dippy Circus

We are very excited to tell you that the Flip and Dippy Circus Show will be visiting school on Thursday 23 April 2020 with the show starting at 6.30pm. The show will

finish at approximately 8pm with an interval part way through. Due to health and safety requirements we are only able to sell 100 tickets for this show.

You can buy tickets via ParentPay from 10am on Monday 16-March. We expect the show to be “SOLD OUT” so you will need to be quick to secure your ticket.

Tickets for the show will be £5 per adult/child/toddler/baby – the show provider’s insurance requires that everybody attending must have a ticket and that all children attending must be accompanied by an adult. You will need a ticket for every person attending.

### Eggtraordinary Easter dress up

School will be holding an Eggtraordinary Easter dress up day on Friday 3 April. Children can dress up in any eggtraordinary way they choose which can be Easter themed but could just be eggtraordinary in another way, for example, clothes on back to front, pants on top of trousers, odd socks or any eggtraordinary way they choose.
