Kineton Green School Covid-19 Parent/ Carer Protocol: September 2020

If your child develops symptoms associated with Covid-19 whilst at **home**, please keep them at home and follow the process outlined below.

If your child develops symptoms associated with Covid-19 whilst **at school**, we will isolate them immediately, providing the support and reassurance they will require. We will contact you and require that you collect them immediately from school and take them straight home. Please take them straight home and follow the same process outlined below.

Step One: CONTACT

Call 111 for advice and request a Covid-19 Test for them online or by calling 119. Do not visit your GP, Pharmacy, hospital or other healthcare provider. Call 999 if emergency care is needed. If you are struggling to access testing, please contact our school office.

Step Two: ISOLATE

Isolate for 10 days after symptoms appear and for longer if their fever continues (until at least 48 hours after their temperature returns to normal). Other people in your household should isolate for 14 days.

Step Three: TEST

Get a test. Testing is carried out at drive-through centres. You must arrive by car and not on foot or via public transport or a taxi. Home tests are available.

Step Four: RESULTS

You should receive your results within 72 hours. If the test is negative, your child and household may stop isolating although they must not return to school until they are well. Please inform us of a negative test result immediately.

Step Five: A POSITIVE TEST RESULT

If your child tests positive for Coronavirus, contact tracers will contact you to inform you of the isolation regulations you will need to follow. Please inform us of a positive test result immediately.

Further notes and guidance:

Home-learning:

If your child is forced to isolate but is in good health, we will continue to set them work via our Class Dojo or Microsoft Teams. Your child's class teacher will keep in touch to ensure that they understand how to access and upload work as required.

If your child is unwell, they are not expected to complete work and we will support them to catch up upon their return to health and to school.

Quarantine:

This is a very uncertain time and our priority is the health, well-being and education of all of our students to ensure that they progress and thrive. Please therefore consider quarantine requirements and FCO advice when booking travel. We will not authorise absence from school for students who have been taken on holiday to a country during a school break where it is already known that travellers must quarantine upon their return to the UK. We would ask you to support us by avoiding booking any foreign travel which may put your child at risk of quarantine and therefore missing important learning in school during this challenging time.

If you do return from a destination where quarantine is needed, please do not send your child to school. Please contact us to inform us of your child's absence and the date that they will return to school following quarantine.

And finally ...

This is a very challenging time for everyone and we are keen to support all members of our community to ensure that we are able to work together to keep everyone safe and well. In order for us to provide the most impactful learning, we want to keep our school open for as many students as possible because we know that students need the routine that school offers them; the opportunity to safely socialise with their peers and the best possible chance of making excellent progress and *become the Bees knees!*
